As a representative on the Tandridge Council, I pledge to advocate tirelessly for Whyteleafe's interests, ensuring our community's needs are prioritised and developed for future generations."


A word from Marcus:

COMMUNITY ACHIEVEMENTS TO DATE

- 1. Achieved Tandridge's only full occupancy shopping district.
- 2.Led efforts to install CCTV in Whyteleafe, resulting in initial installation at traffic lights and ongoing advocacy for broader coverage.
- 3. Assisted new families settling in Whyteleafe by providing furniture, clothing, and support with school placements.
- 4. Facilitated new businesses in obtaining street licenses, contributing to the development of a vibrant village center.
- 5. Advocated for expanded Christmas lights and decorations across Whyteleafe, as demonstrated by recent installations.
- 6.Conducted regular inspections of flood defenses with the Environment Agency, resulting in the removal of over three tonnes of silt.
- 7. Successfully campaigned for the re-tarmacing of the high street, ensuring improved infrastructure.
- 8. Advocated for enhanced street cleaning throughout Whyteleafe village.
- 9. Secured a disabled parking space outside a café in Whyteleafe for the benefit of elderly and disabled residents.
- 10. Successfully extended the 434 bus route to Caterham.
- 11.Established the new 439 bus route connecting Whyteleafe to Waddon Marsh, including the tram stop.
- 12. Secured an additional stop at Norwood Junction for Crystal Palace fans and improved access to London Overground trains to Docklands/Canary Wharf.
- 13.Increased morning and evening peak Thameslink services on the East Grinstead branch, with 12 additional carriages and more late-night services introduced.
- 14. Advocated for the reinstatement of the Victoria peak service on the Caterham Branch.
- 15.Initiated steps for Upper Warlingham Station to become step-free with the installation of lifts.
- 16.Upgraded amenities at Whyteleafe South, including new seating, ticket machines, a bridge, and pending installation of two shelters for customer comfort.
 - 17. Successfully campaigned against excessive houses of multiple occupation in Whyteleafe.
